The 2010 Ohio Spring Race Series Finale brings back a long time favorite of the cycling community, St. Leon, IN. This is a slightly modified route from years past with plenty of twists and turns to start each loop before gradually dropping you into the valley. Once in the valley, you'll make that right turn and climb up the steep and rugged Lookout Dr. Once back on top, you spend the next several miles on a long rolling straightaway fighting fierce crosswind. Each lap is 18 miles in length.

*If less than 25 riders in either category, the fields will be combined, the Cat 3 purse will be eliminated, but they will still be scored separately.

PARKING: We will use the parking lot at St Peter Church, 1207 East Rd. (corner of St Peter Rd and East Rd), Brookville, IN 47012. The parking lot probably won't handle 150 cars, so **carpooling is encouraged**. If you feel your training may not have been enough for this race, Mass starts at 8 AM.

REGISTRATION: Online registration is available at BikeReg.com. Online registration will close at noon on Saturday, May 22, 2010. Pre-registration is highly encouraged. A \$10 late fee will be assessed to all day of event registrations. Onsite registration and check in will be at St Peters carry Out & Deli, 12203 St Peters Rd, Brookville, IN 47012 and will be open 10 AM until 11:45 AM on race day. Please do not park at the Deli.

RULES AND REGULATIONS: All USA Cycling rules and regulations must be followed and will be enforced. All riders must have a current USA Cycling racing license or a one-day license. One-day licenses will be available at check in and can only be used by Cat 5 Men and Cat 4 Women. The promoter reserves the right to combine categories and/or reduce prize lists based upon number of riders.

SERIES RULES: Each racer will be issued ONE bib number for the entire series. You must use the same bib number at all races in the series. Replacement bib numbers will be \$10. Each race will contribute \$1 for each rider to the general classification for the series' prizes.

RESULTS: All results will be submitted to USA Cycling within 48 hours after the official results are final.
